## **Booking**

Access tickets can be booked online or by contacting the Box Office on **0118 370 2620**. In order to book online, customers with any accessibility requirements should initially contact the Box Office by email **boxoffice@readingrep.com** or phone **0118 370 2620**. We can then set up an account (if necessary) and the facility for you to book online in the future. Simple instructions can be provided to help assist with this.

Patrons who require a personal assistant in order to attend the theatre, will be entitled to one free ticket. Registered assistance dogs are welcome but we ask patrons to inform us at the point of booking to ensure you are best placed for the safety of yourself and companion.

We urge anyone with any additional questions or requirements to contact the Box Office, who can provide detailed guidance and information to ensure your visit is as enjoyable as possible.

## **Assisted Performances**

- Touch Tours Enable people to explore the set, costumes and props prior to a
  performance. No ticket is required, just come along at the allotted time (see
  brochure or website for times) and gather in the foyer where a member of
  staff will greet you
- Audio Description Live narration makes performances more accessible for those who are blind or visually impaired. Describing changes of location and facial expressions, or giving context and setting the scene through discreet headphones, provided on arrival.
- Relaxed Relaxed performances are specifically designed to welcome people
  who will enjoy a more relaxed atmosphere. Typically, performances will
  include reduced lighting, soft sound effects and a friendly view on noise and
  movement in and around the auditorium.
- BSL Performances feature a British Sign Language Interpreter on or to the side of the stage. They interpret the spoken word and sound effects of the performance for those who communicate using BSL.
